Shelter Support Worker Micro-Credential Program

A FREE, IN-DEPTH PROGRAM TO JUMPSTART YOUR CAREER IN THE HOMELESS OR FAMILY VIOLENCE SHELTER SECTOR

The 6-month program will begin October 2024 and will consist of:

- (1) 90-hour foundation training in basic shelter terminology and concepts
- (2) 90-hour training in shelter fundamentals in skills needed to work in a shelter
- (3) Specialization in either homeless or FV shelters for the next 90-hour segment
- (4) 20-hour work placement at a shelter (for those that don't already work at a shelter)
- (5) 20-hour capstone project—research & propose solutions to a topic concerning the shelter

What you'll need

- (1) Access to a computer and internet (we can help you obtain a computer from Computers for Schools)
- (2) Commitment to completing the program, which will take about 6 months. The time commitment will be about 10-15 hours per week. Most of the work will be done on the students' own time, with 1 live session per week.
- (3) Complete an application including a cover letter and resume
- (4) Complete an interview with Manitoba Association of Women's Shelters
